George Stewart and Jeff Hartley, both members of the RRC and of Liverpool Pembroke set off at 8.30 a.m. accompanied by a few other runners from time to time for the fun of the thing. Hartley led by 20 minutes at the end of the first lap and increased this to 23 minutes at 25 miles, which he reached in 3 hours 15 minutes. At 38 miles however, Stewart reduced the lead to 17 minutes and then set about catching the younger man, which he did three miles from the finish. He finished full of running in 7 hours 20 minutes 30 seconds, Jeff Hartley's time being 7 hours 24 minutes 57 seconds".
